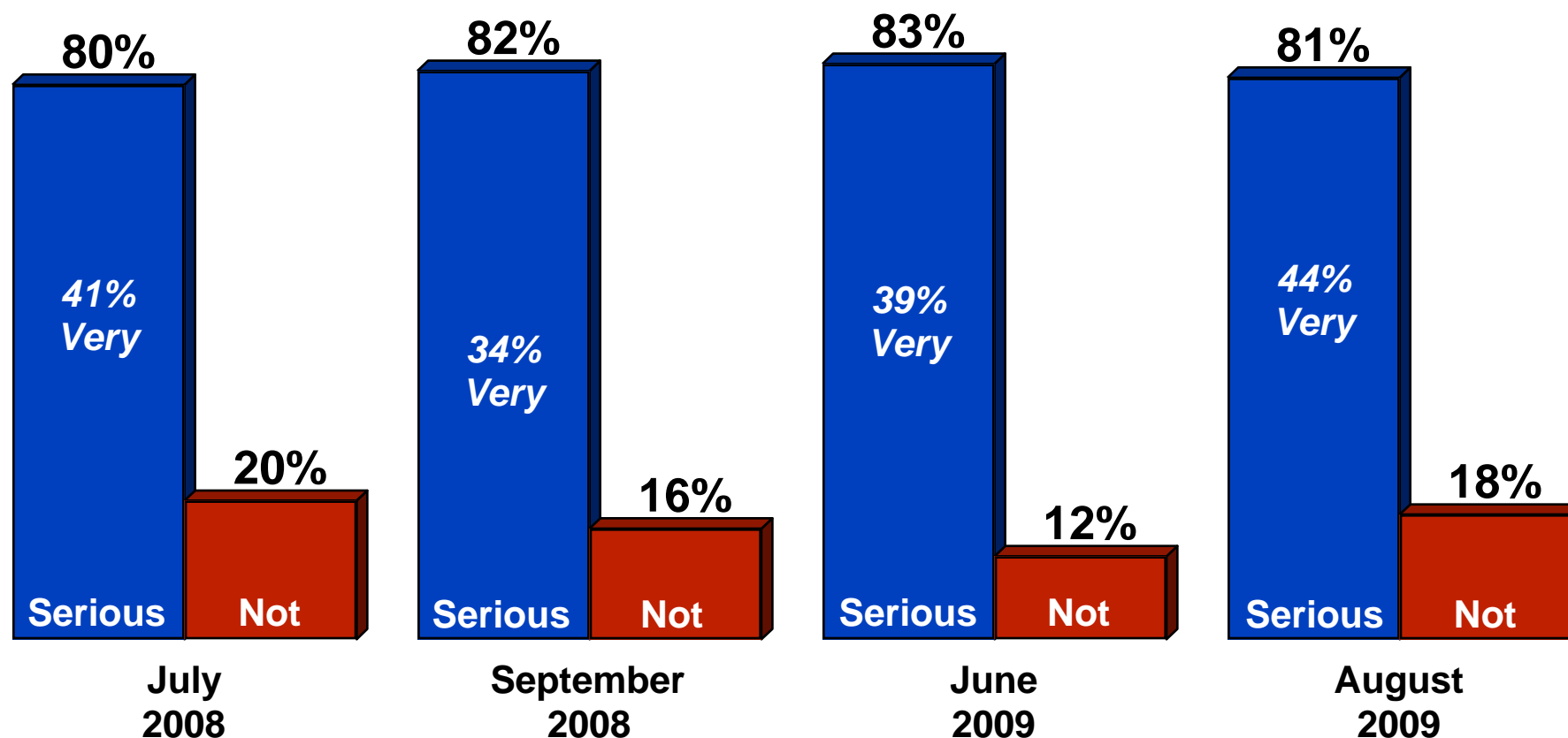

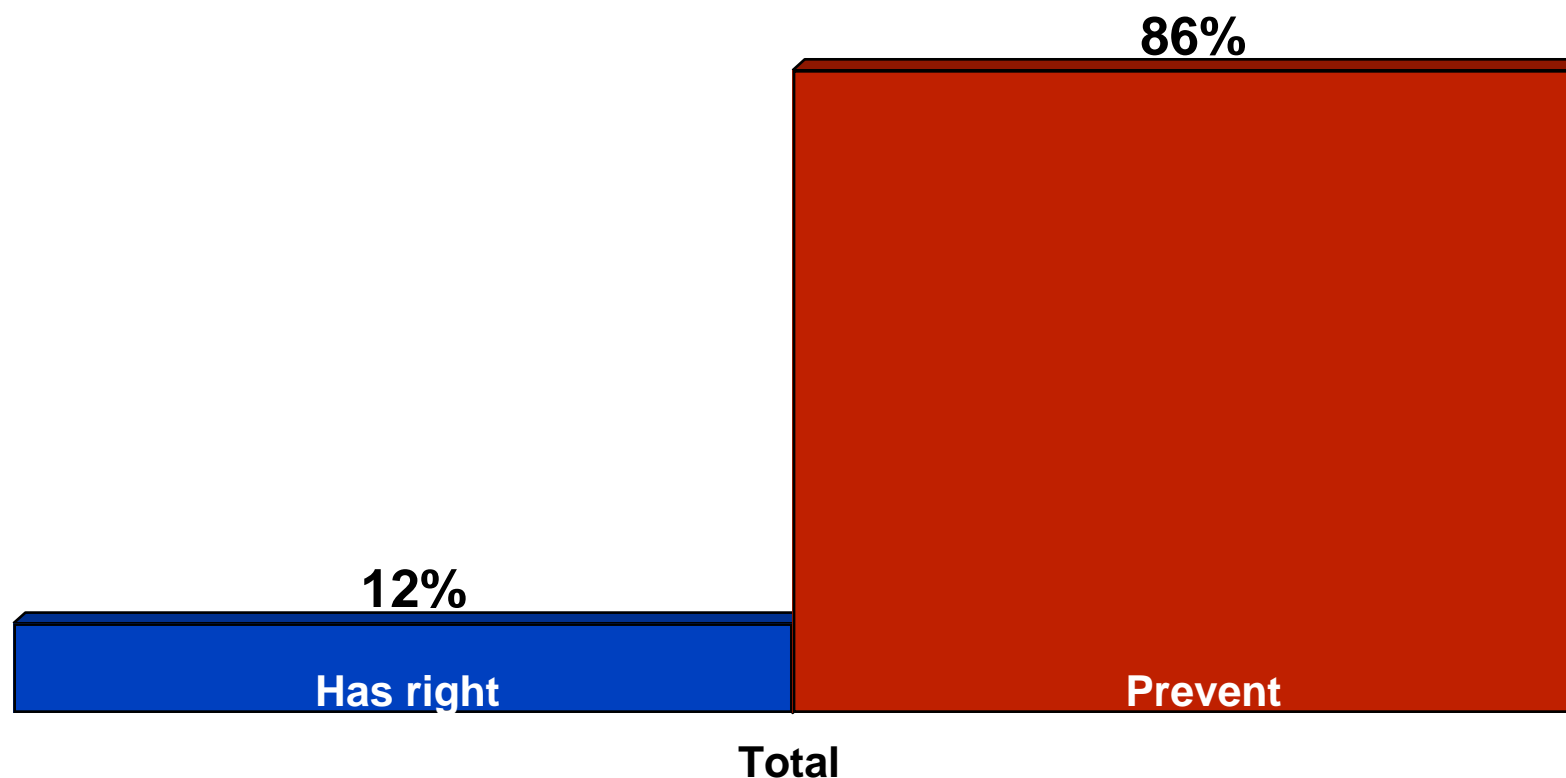
# US attitudes have changed little on Iran's threat to the US.

# There is a consensus among Americans that the international community should prevent Iran from developing nuclear weapons.

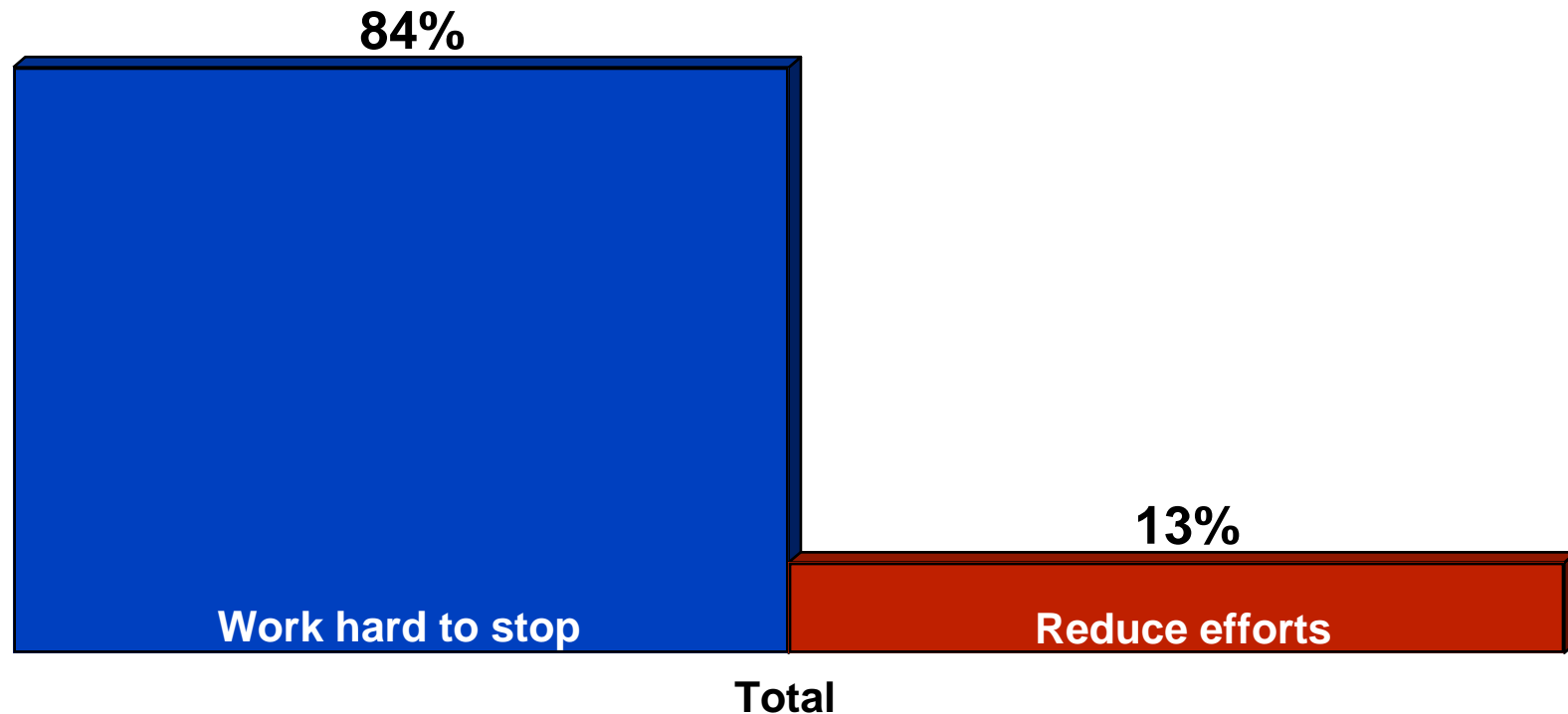

# Americans believe that even with the problems the nation faces, we must still work hard to prevent Iran from getting nuclear weapons.

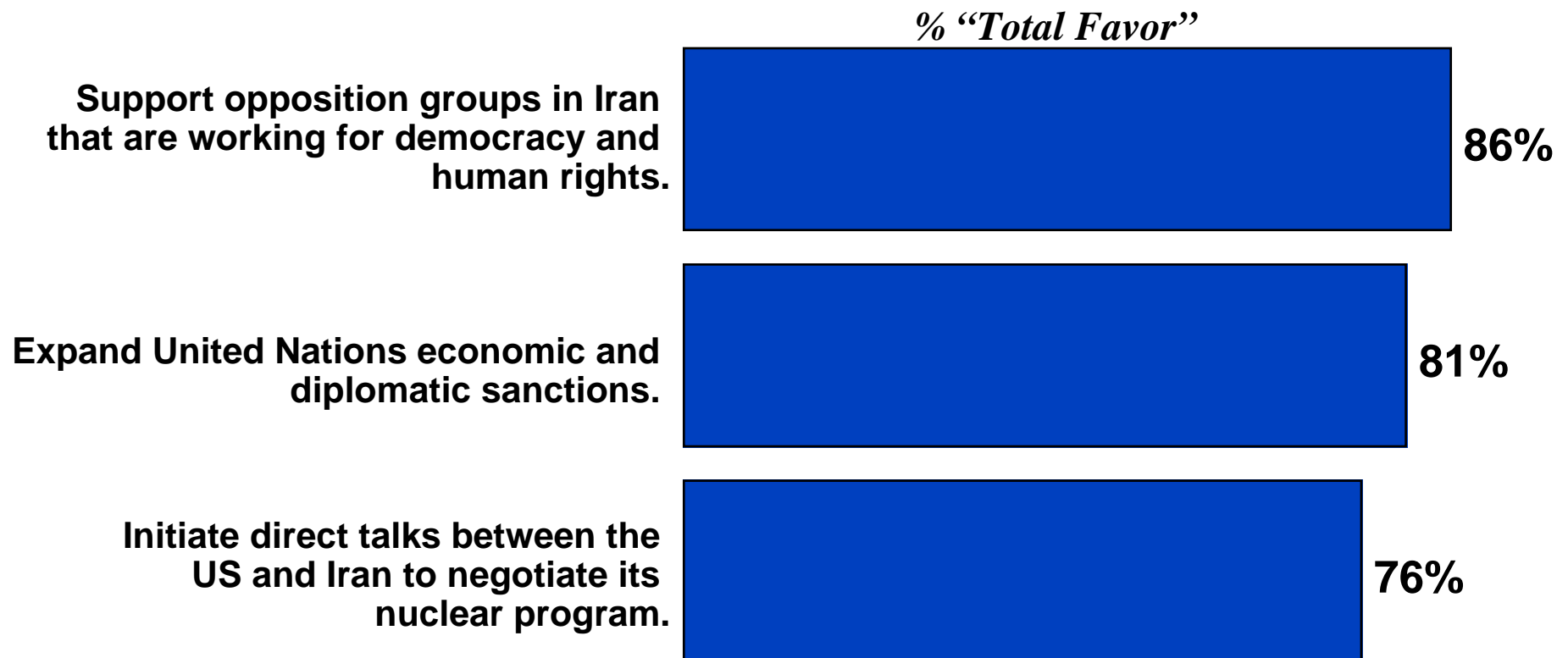
*Which statement comes closer to your own opinion?*
