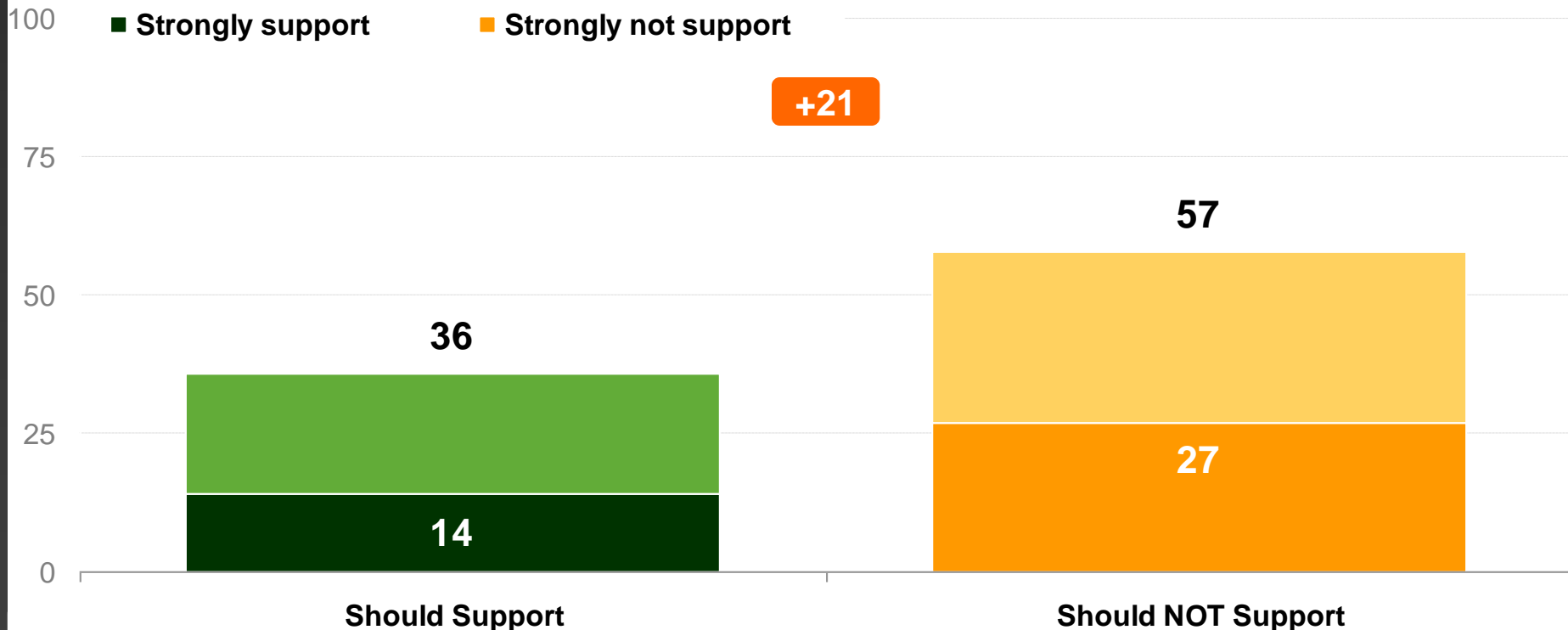
Unilateral Declaration of a Palestinian State

Should the German government recognize a unilaterally-declared independent Palestinian state?

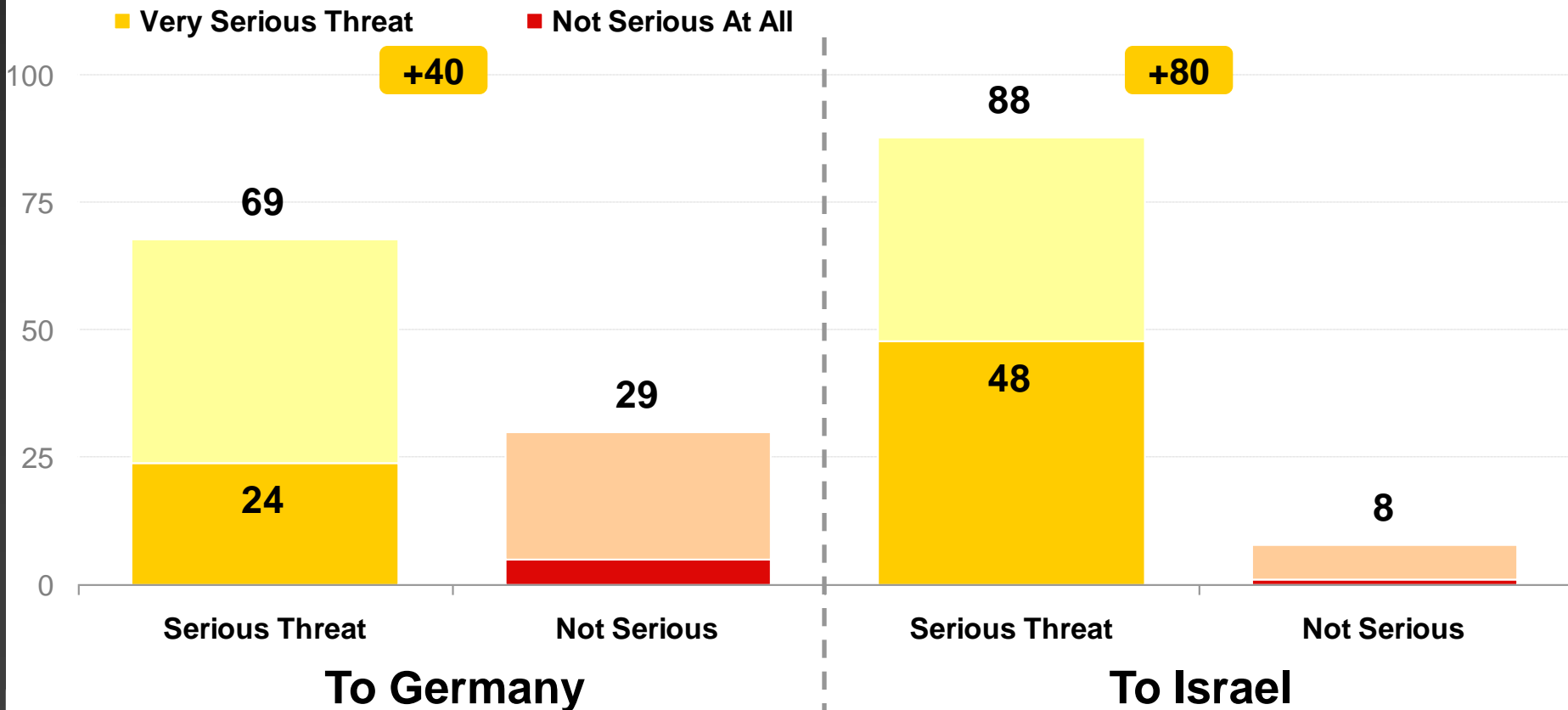


The question of Iran

No doubt Iranian nuclear capability poses threat – especially to Israel

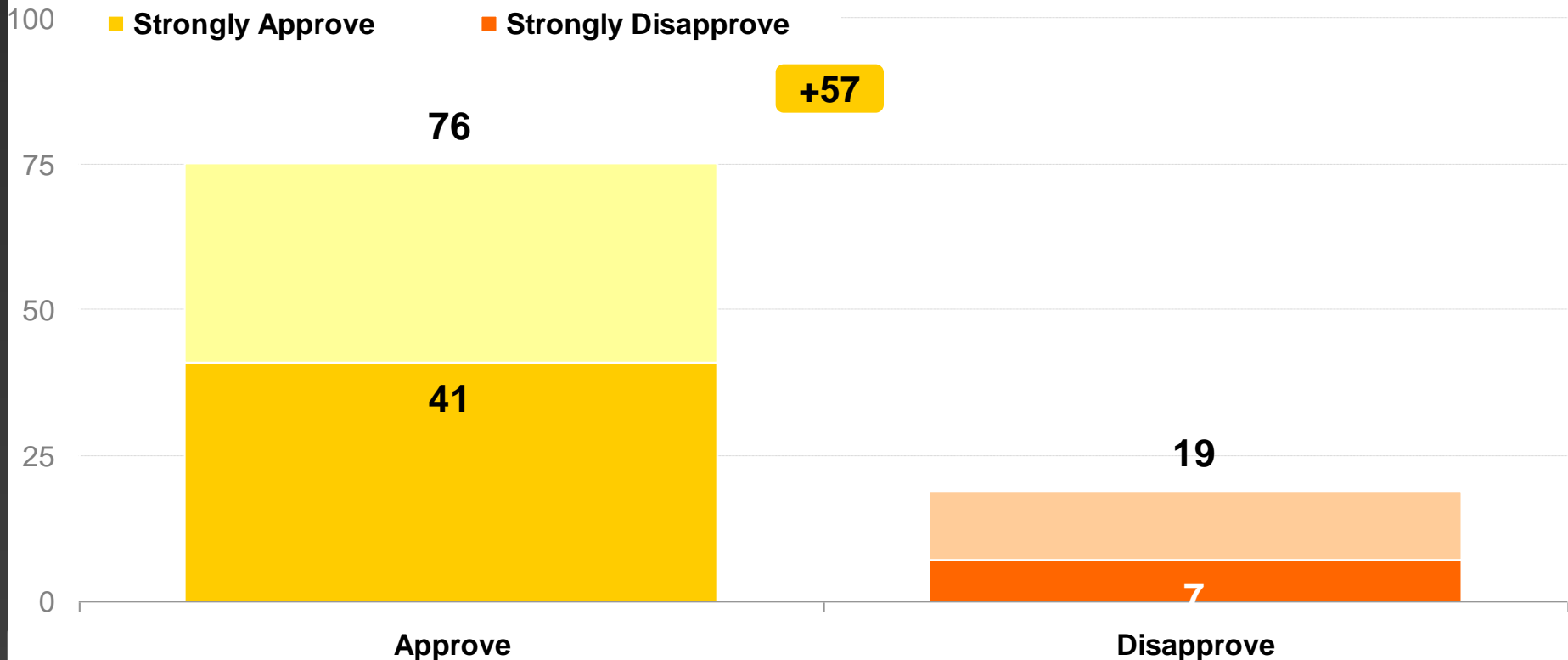

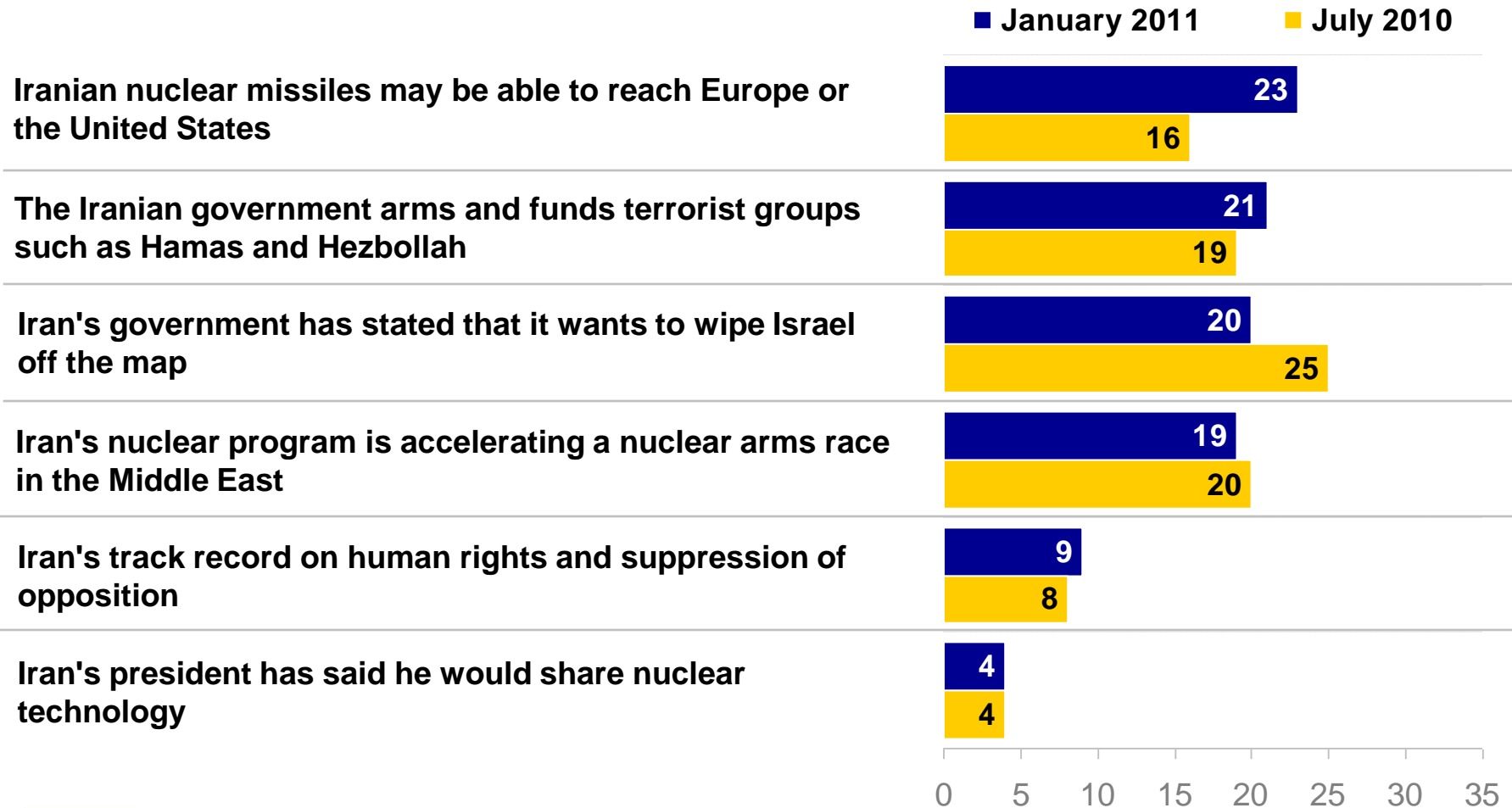
UN and EU sanctions against Iran should be enforced, even against Germany companies
