



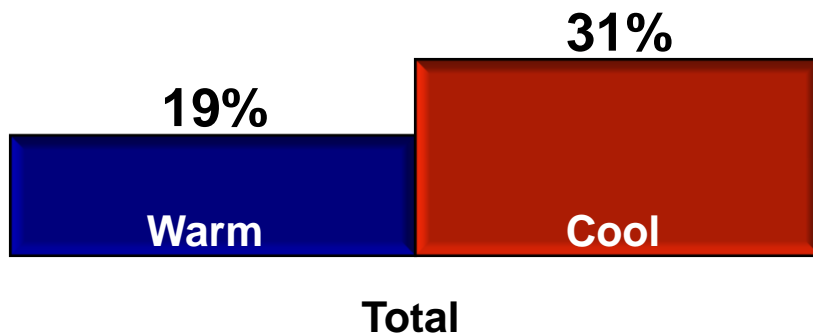
Opinions on Israeli-Palestinian Peace Talks in UK

conducted April 2011 by Greenberg Quinlan Rosner Research.

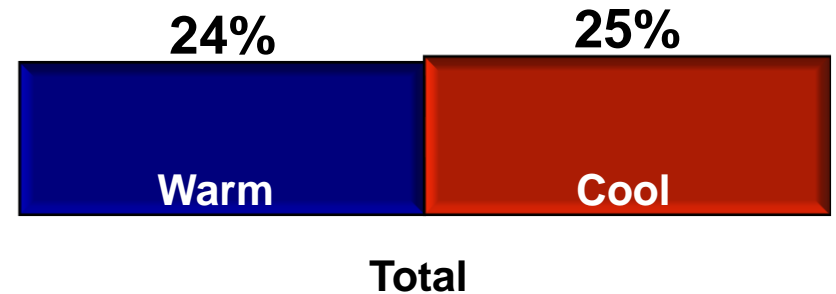
Israel and the Palestinians are viewed coolly.

Israel

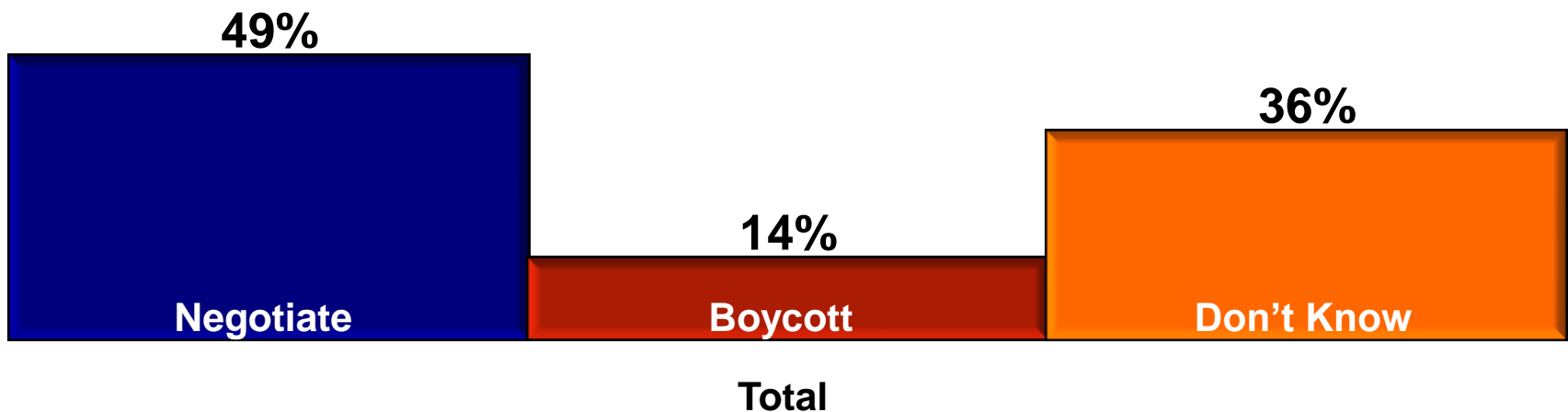


The Palestinians
